



PRINCE2® Foundation & Practitioner Autumn '09 Course Dates*



PRINCE2® is the world's leading project management methodology. It is a generic methodology and therefore *applicable to managing all types and sizes of projects*. Obtainment of recognised professional project management qualifications can dramatically improve both individual and organisational success. Two levels of accreditation are currently available – Foundation and Practitioner. Public courses are available on the dates listed below:

16th – 20th November 2009
7th - 11th December 2009

Location: Belfast (*venue will be confirmed on booking*).

Candidates wishing to sit Foundation or Practitioner can attend the same course but Foundation candidates will only be required to attend the first three days. The Foundation Examination will take place on Day 3. Candidates wishing to sit Practitioner must obtain a pass in the Foundation examination as a pre-requisite to sitting the Practitioner Examination on the afternoon of the 5th day. Practitioner candidates are therefore required to attend all 5 days.

Summary Programme Structure:

Pre-course work is strongly recommended but not essential. Pre-course pack issued in advance, by arrangement.

Days 1 -2:	9.30am-5pm: Tuition, <i>supplemented with practice papers</i>
Day 3:	9.30am-3pm: Tuition
Day 3:	3pm-4pm: Foundation Exam (<i>trainer will confirm time during course</i>)
Day 4:	9.30am-5pm: Tuition, <i>supplemented with practitioner practice papers</i> .
Day 5:	9.30am-1pm: Tuition
Day 5:	1pm-4pm Practitioner Exam (<i>trainer will confirm time during the course</i>)

PRINCE2 Foundation: £750 per person, plus VAT (10% discount for early booking).

PRINCE2 Practitioner: £1,250 per person, plus VAT (10% discount for early booking).

The cost includes: pre-course pack (containing study guide & PRINCE2 Manual), tuition, course notation, exam fees. Lunch and refreshments also included. Pre-course packs may be collected from Elite. Arrangements can be made for delivery (additional charges apply for delivery).
